Before you proceed, make sure you can answer Yes to the following questions.

Fill in all relevant details and attach any supporting documents relevant to your application. Remember; *ALL* applications must have examples of previous work, a script, a completed budget and risk assessments for any confirmed locations **AND** be delivered to us, completed by **20th September 2025**

Step 2

Submit your application before the closing date of 2nd June 2025.

Step 3

Cross your fingers and wait until we announce our final decisions by 30th June 2025.

2) Where are you making your film?

Tell us where your film takes place and if you have considered any potential locations for filming. Are you aware of any potential problems that locations may pose? Remember; at least 50% of your locations must be in the Midlands. Please attach a risk assessment for any of the locations you have confirmed. (Templates are available from Reel Brum upon request)

3) Who are you working with?

Before any application can be considered, projects must have a Producer and either a Writer or Director already attached. Please provide details of who these individuals are. Details must include name, age/d.o.b., full address, links to previous work, (imdB page/website/showreels etc.) and social media links. Statements about creative intentions for the film, from one or both can also be submitted if attached as a separate document.

4) Who ELSE are you working with?

Have you discussed this project with any other **potential** cast or other crew members? If so; who are you hoping to work with, what is their backgrounds and why are they the best people to help bring this project to life? Remember; at least 50% of your cast or crew **must** be Midlands based.

4) What is your budget?

Please note: A key part of this grant is that everybody involved with this production **MUST** be paid fairly.

How would you spend the £5000 if you were successful? You can allocate your funds to any part of the production. Be as detailed as possible and show your breakdowns. Only projects with a completed budget will be considered. You will need to keep all evidence of your expenditure if you receive a grant. If you prefer, you can create your budget using any template or format that you feel appropriate and attach it as a separate document.

- No applications will be considered if they arrive after the deadline of 02.06.2025 Applicants will be notified by 30.06.2025 as to the outcome of their applications. Films MUST be completed by the 20.07.2025
